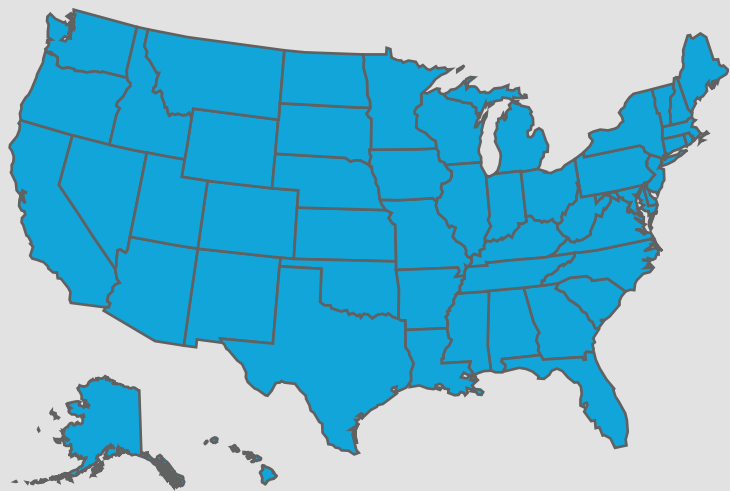

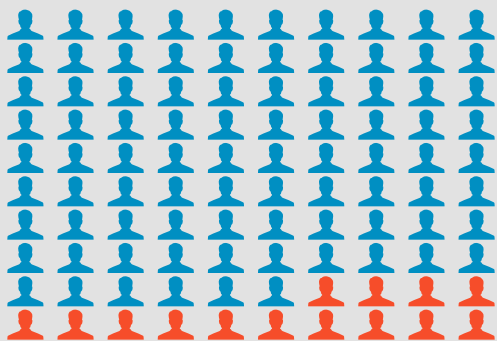

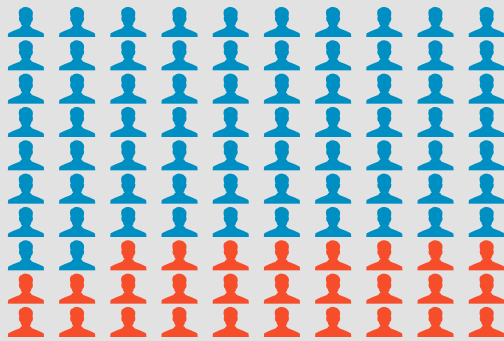
In the U.S.

In 2003, 40 million people needed literacy and numeracy help

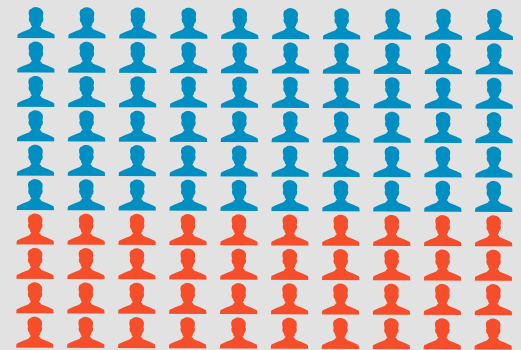
In 2008, 25% of the labor force was functioning at a low basic educational skill level



86% of adults age 25 to 64 with a bachelor's or higher participated in the workforce in 2014

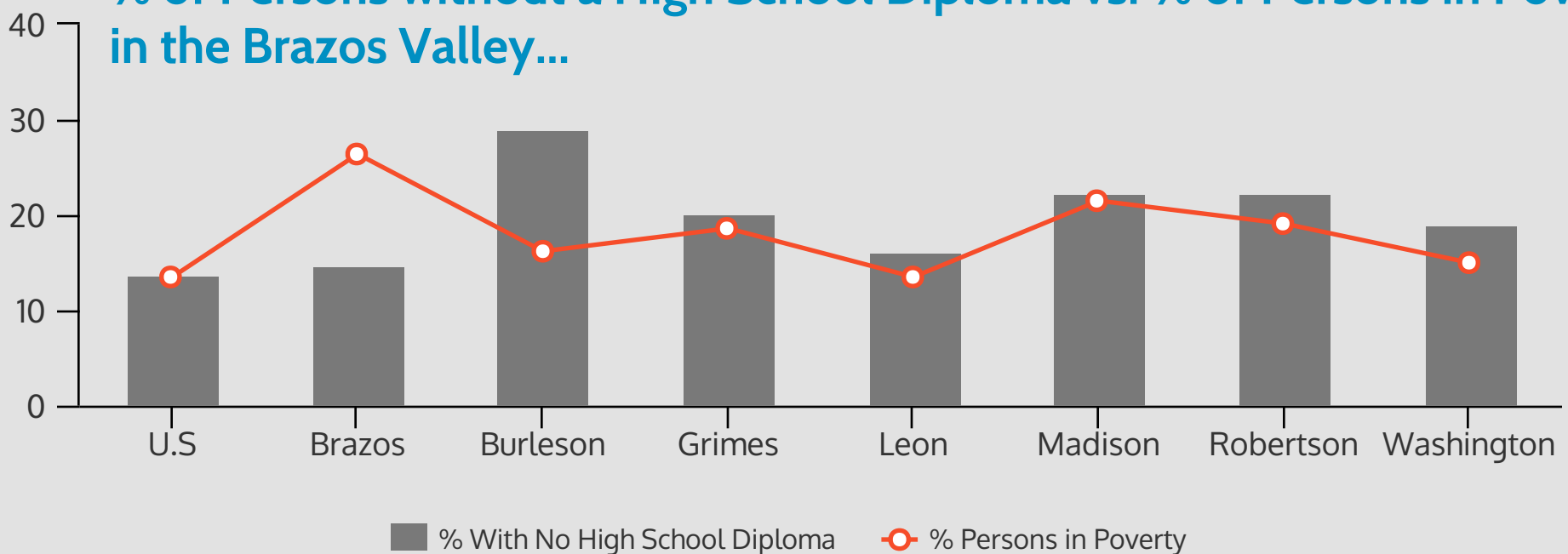


72% of adults age 25 to 64 with a high school diploma participated in the workforce in 2014

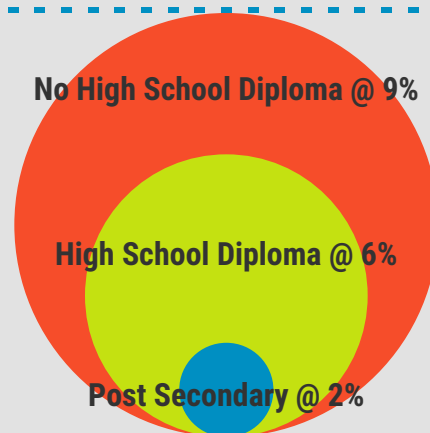


60% of adults age 25 to 64 with no high school diploma participated in the workforce in 2014
